
Route 2 – Main campus 3.81 mi - approximately 1 hr 45 min 40 Sculptures: **01 - 30, 37 - 46**

**Route 4 - Full Sculpture Walk** 4 mi - approximately 2 hr 46 Sculptures: **01 - 46** 








