Route 1 - Short walk
1.25 mi - approximately 45 min.
15 Sculptures: **01 - 08, 24 - 25, 37 - 46**

Route 2 - Main campus
3.81 mi - approximately 1 hr 45 min
40 Sculptures: **01 - 30, 37 - 46**

Route 3 - Outdoor sculptures
3.5 mi - approximately 1 hr
24 Sculptures: **01, 03 - 06, 09, 11 - 16, 18, 21, 24 - 27, 29 - 30**

Route 4 - Full Sculpture Walk
4 mi - approximately 2 hr
46 Sculptures: **01 - 46**

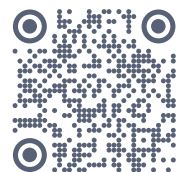
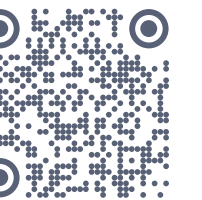
