Figure 2. The surgery below was an amputee of a hind leg because it was the second time it had shattered in two weeks.

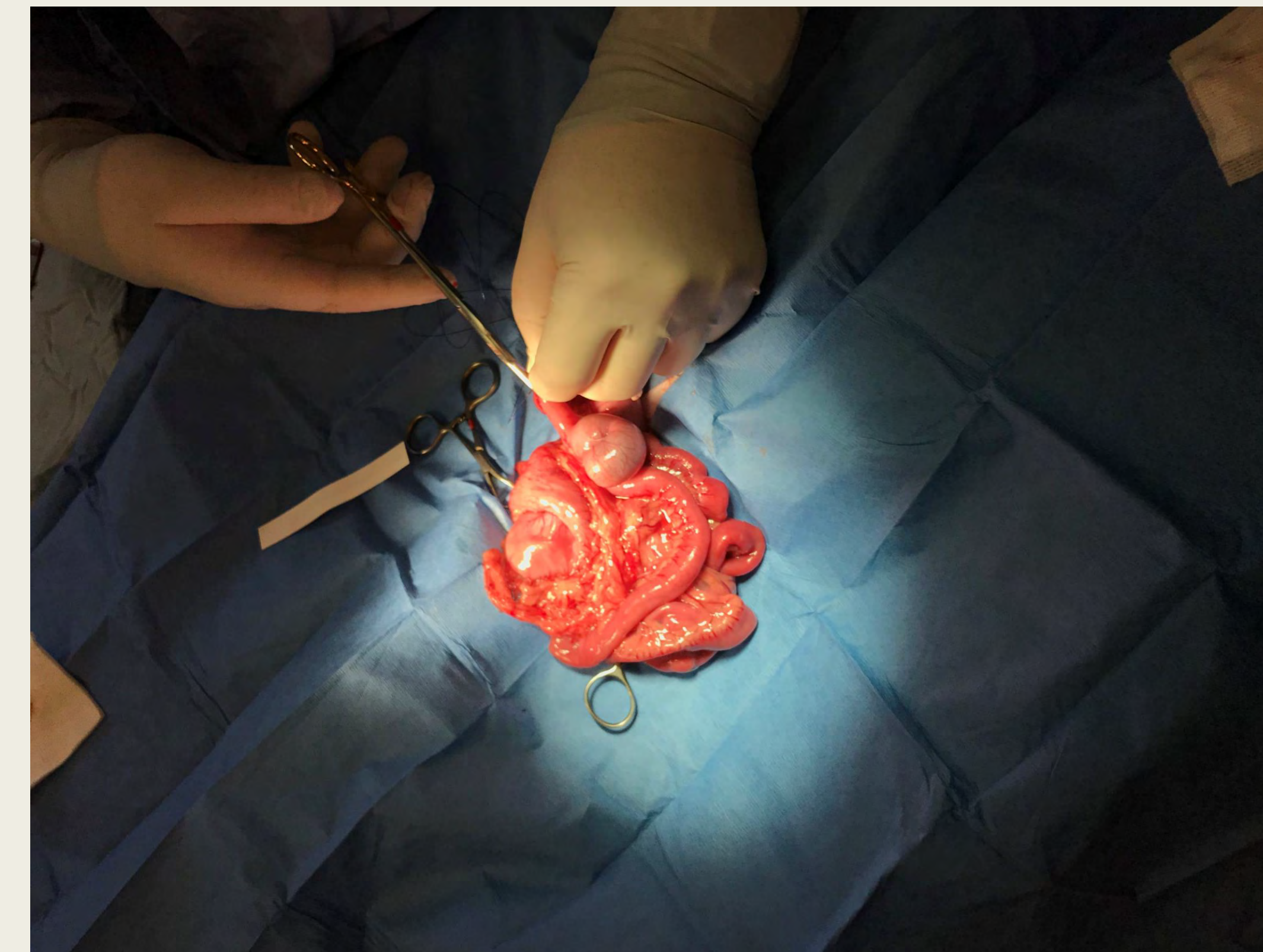
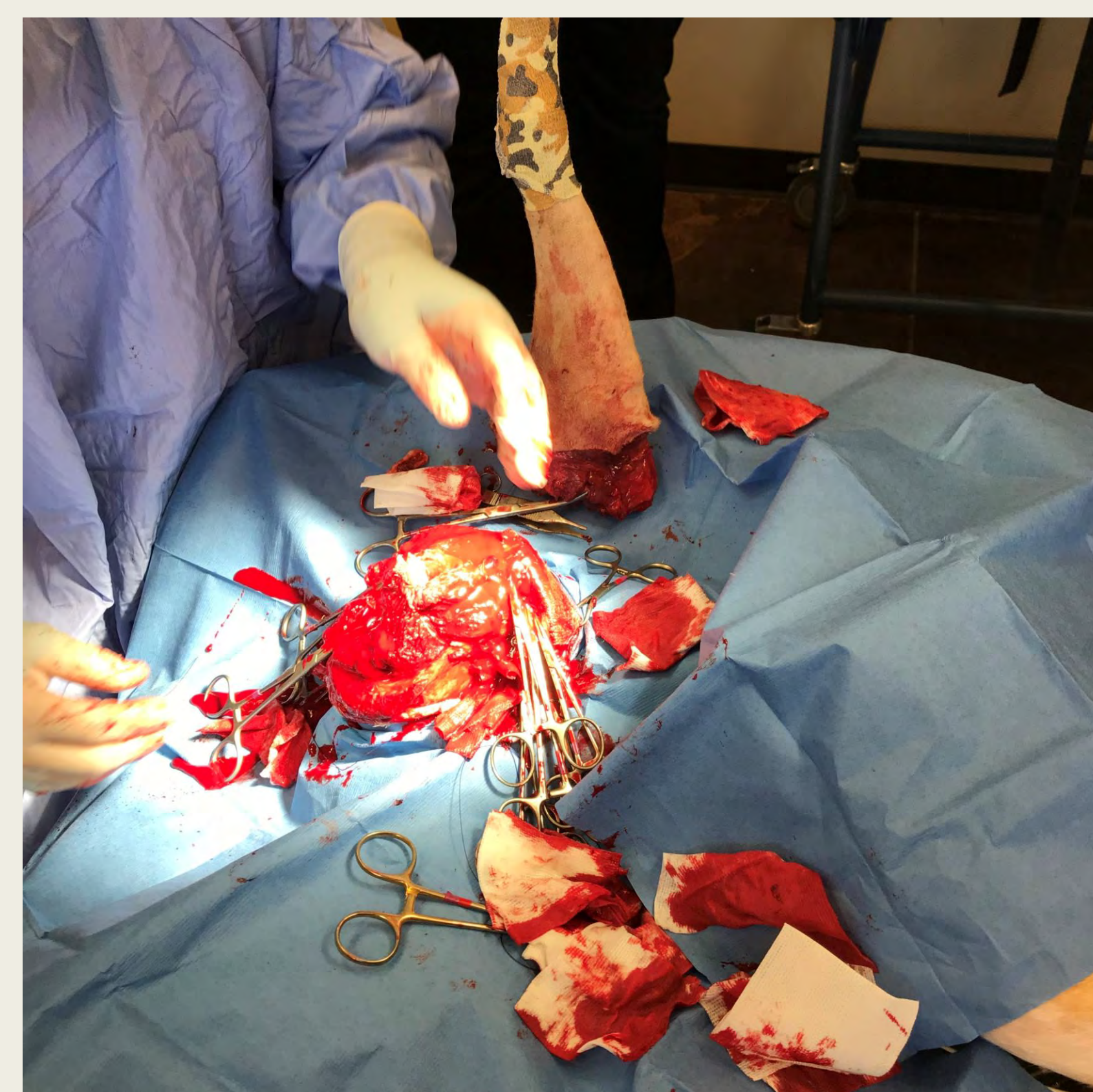
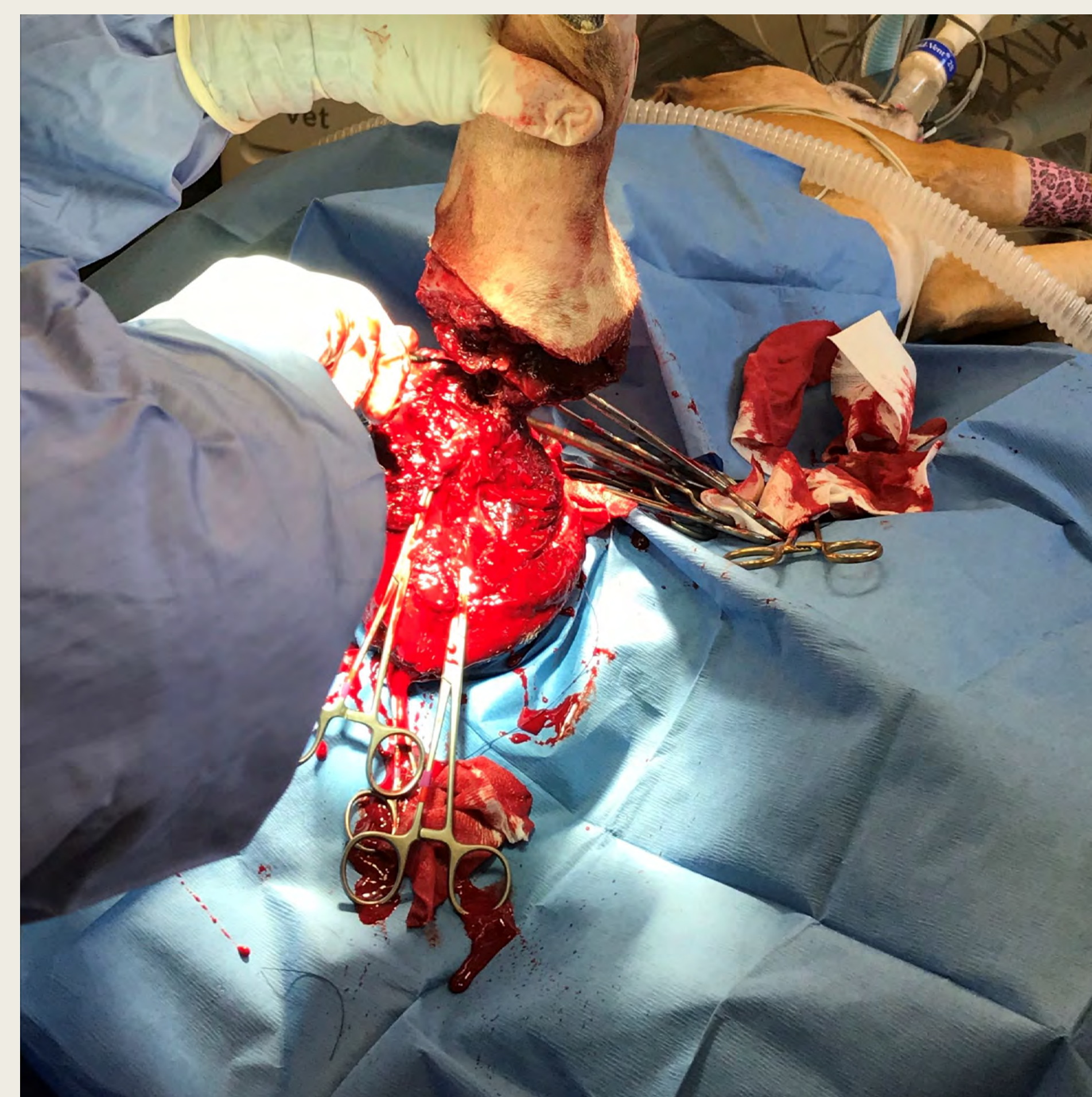


Figure 1. The pictures to the right are of a surgery to retrieve a swallowed marble.

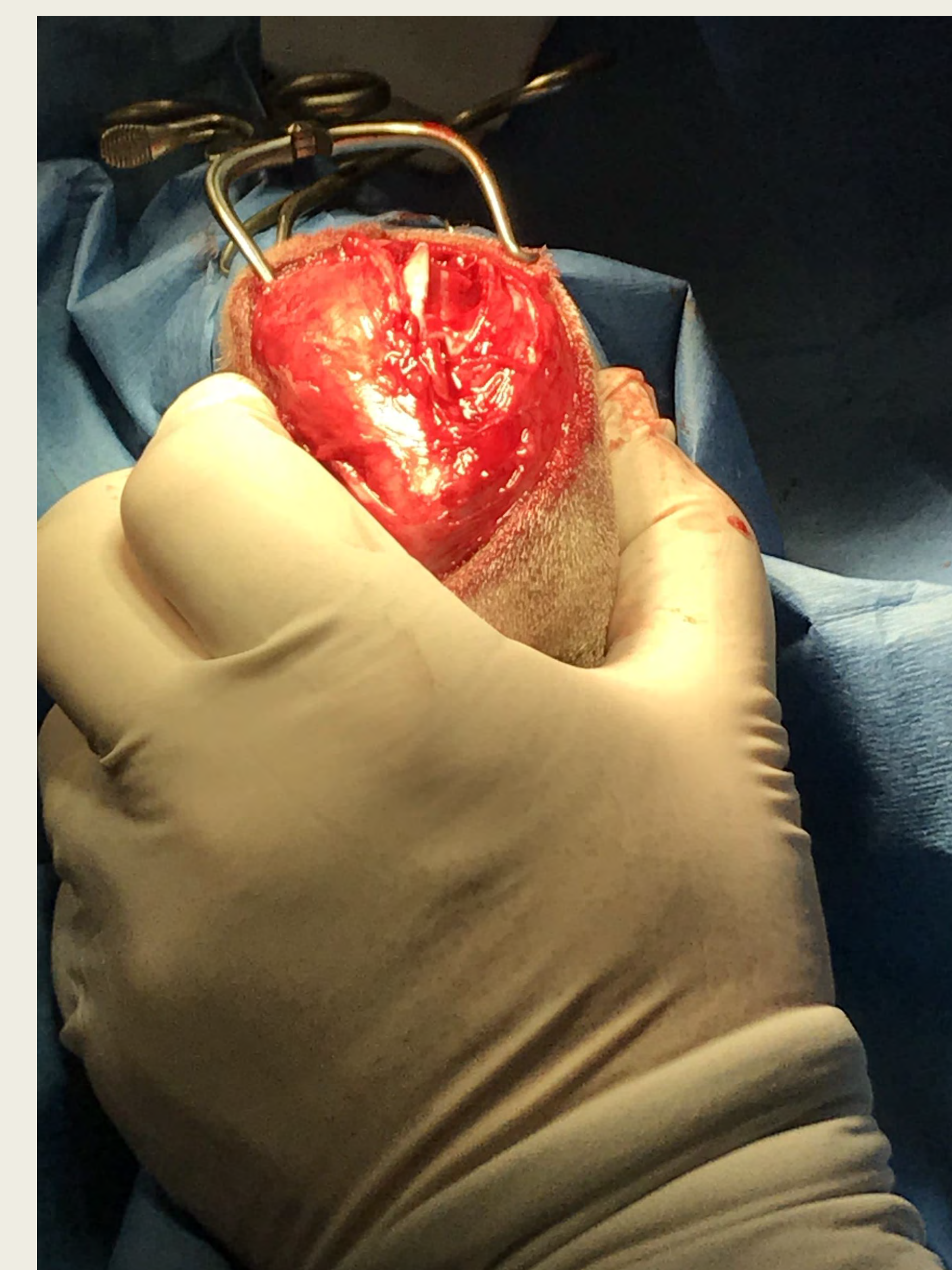
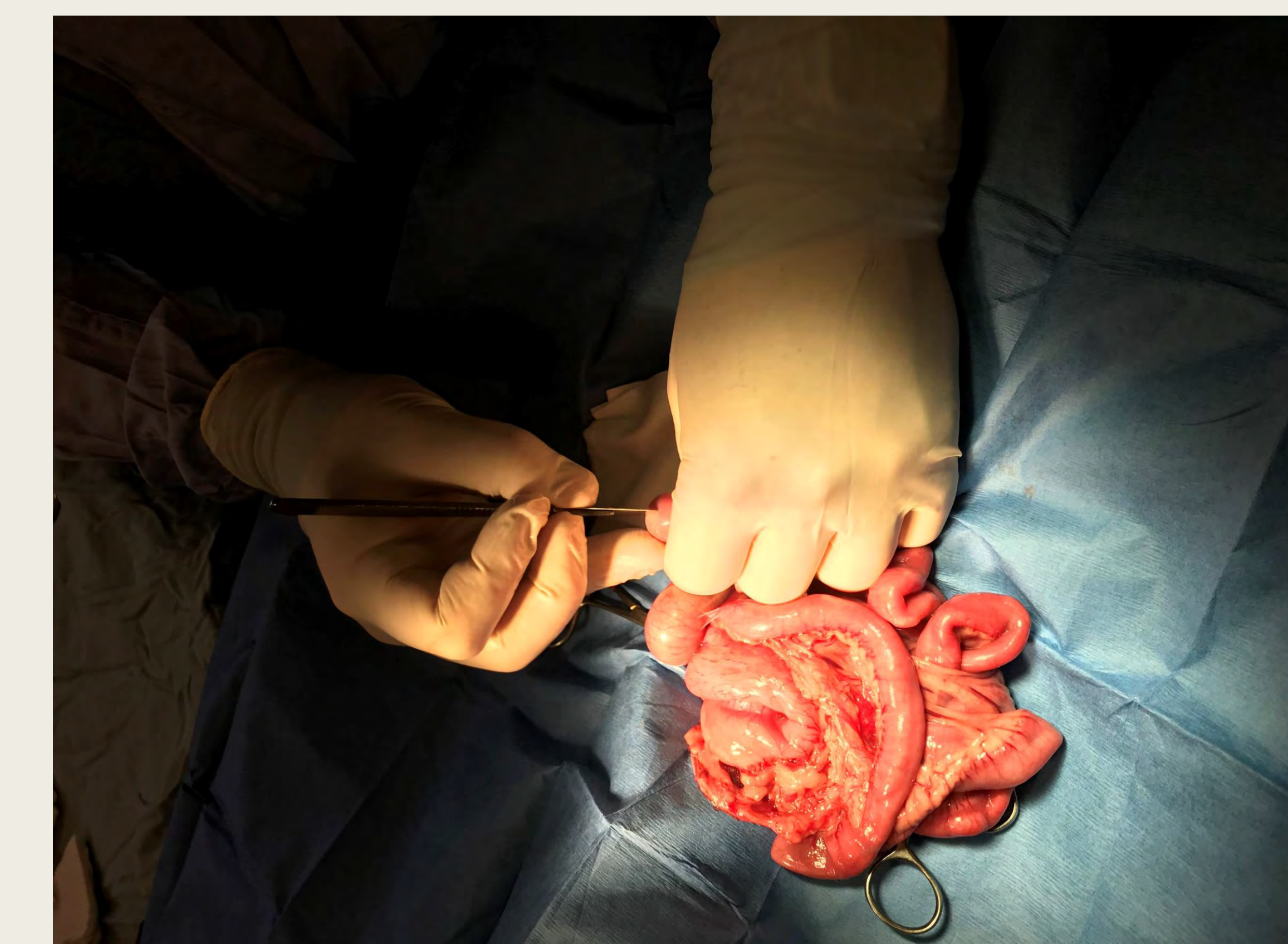


Figure 3. This surgery was to increase the groove that the patella slides in on the knee in order to prevent it from dislocating again.
