Job Summary

OP Climbing Wall Attendant is a student position designed to facilitate the operation of the Outdoor Programs climbing wall. The position will mainly focus on safety and customer service.

Job Duties

- Assist climbers checking into the facility and filling out waivers.
- · Assist climbers with equipment rentals and fitting.
- Provide high levels of customer service.
- Handle cash and card transactions.
- Maintain rental gear in good and working condition.
- Perform belay testing/ classes. (Certified staff)
- Oversee the safe use of the climbing facility.
- Set and reset routes. Clean holds.
- Maintain the outstanding condition and cleanliness of the ARC OP climbing wall space
- This position description indicates the general nature and level of work performed by employees within this classification. It is not designed to contain or be interpreted as a comprehensive list of all duties, responsibilities, and qualifications required of employees assigned to the position.

Qualifications

Required

- Strong climbing knowledge.
- Ability to pass belay and climbing test.

Preferred

- PCIA or AMGA CWI (climbing wall instructor) certification.
- Prior climbing gym or retail experience.
- Route setting experience.

Position Details

- The position reports to the Assistant Director of Outdoor Programs & Coordinator of Outdoor Programs
- Hourly wage starts at \$8.75/hour



- Employees can expect to work 10-29 hours per week
- Employees will be required to work some weekend and/or night shifts.
