



JOB TITLE: Intramural Sports Official

Job Summary

Intramural Sports Official is a student position designed to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all spectators and participants. The position will mainly focus on officiating the offered intramural sports, which include (but are not limited to) flag football, soccer, futsal, basketball, volleyball, and softball.

Job Duties

- Be aware of and retain all rules and policies for each Intramural Sports and overall program
- Display premier customer service at all times, as this position represents not only Intramural Sports but also the Campus Recreation Department
- Attend all required meetings and training each semester
- Clock in on time according to your shift on WhenToWork
- Help the Competitive Sports Supervisor set up field/court
- Make sure game begins on time
- Consult with other officials and the Competitive Sports Supervisor to handle any protests, ejections, injuries, and sportsmanship score
- This position description indicates the general nature and level of work performed by employees within this classification. It is not designed to contain or be interpreted as a comprehensive list of all duties, responsibilities, and qualifications required of employees assigned to the position.

Qualifications

Required

- No officiating experience is required
- Officials must be a current student taking at least 1 credit hour
- Cell phones should not be visible/used during the game (only in between games briefly)

Preferred

- Any previous experience officiating a sport or sports at any level

Position Details

- The position reports to the Coordinator of Competitive Sports and/or Graduate Assistant of Competitive Sports



- Hourly wage starts at \$8.50/hour
- Employees can expect to work 10-12/hours per week
- Employees will be required to work some weekend and/or night shift (if applicable)
- Use of AggieTime (program for clocking in/out) and WhenToWork (scheduling software)
