Job Summary

An Outdoor Programs Trip Leader is a student passionate about the outdoors who is willing to spend their time and energy helping other students engage in various outdoor experiences. Student trip leaders enjoy working with others and are competent in one or more outdoor activities.

Job Duties

- Plan, organize and lead adventure-based outdoor trips in a variety of activities.
- Communicate trip logistics and expectations with participants.
- Instruct participants on outdoor activity skills and ethics.
- Oversee safety and risk management of trip participants in dynamic outdoor environments.
- Demonstrate the proper use of outdoor equipment and maintain OP equipment.
- Enforce OP and University policies

Qualifications

Required

- Self-motivated with desire to share outdoor experiences with others.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Valid driver's license.
- Wilderness First Aid Certification (within first year of hire).
- Competent in one or more outdoor activities.
- Ability to work nights, weekends and holidays.
- Ability to lift 50 lbs and perform necessary outdoor activity skills unassisted.

Preferred

- Previous outdoor leadership/guide experience.
- Wilderness First Responder Certification (within first year of hire).
- Whitewater rafting, backcountry ski/board, mountain biking experience.



Position Details

- The position reports to the Coordinator of Outdoor Programs
- Hourly wage starts at \$7.50/hour. Trips are stipend pay when eligible.
- Employees can expect to work, on average, 10+ hours per week.
