

Definitions

- Activity counts were a sum total of events posted on the USUSA
 MyUSU Group page and the scheduled FSL activities.
- Organization and club funding were sum totals of the following organizations and the amount each was given by the SILC Office:
 - \$8,224.60 = Club Funding
 - \$9,000 = Inclusion Center
 - \$8,000 = International Student Councils
 - \$21,303 = Service Center
 - \$500 = Aggiethon at Campus Rec
- Student Officer Scholarships are not GPA based. Students must have a minimum of a 2.75 GPA to eligible
- Scholarships were the sum total of scholarships awarded out by the Student Involvement and Leadership Center.
- Service hours were calculated using the logged service hours of the Spirit Squad and FSL. USUSA events were estimated by the time of the event multiplied by the estimated number of committee members that participated. This total number of service hours that were added to the logged hours.
- Testimonials were provided by students who participated in qualitative surveys. Feedback was received from USUSA events as well as student leaders giving feedback on their leadership experience.
- Total engagement and percentage of those engaged were derived from those who swiped their student cards at USUSA and athletic events.
- Social media followers for each platform is a sum of followers for each page that is affiliated with the SILC Office. The posts were sum totals of the same profiles for the 2022-2023 year.
