Order of Omega History

The Order of Omega was founded at the University of Miami in the fall of 1959 by a group of outstanding fraternity men, who felt that individuals in the Greek community should be recognized for their service to the fraternity system and the University. There are now over 300 chapters in the United States. The Delta Phi chapter at Utah State University was founded and chartered on January 17th, 1983. Since our founding, we have initiated hundreds of men and women and look forward to initiating new members into our organization.

Responsibilities

All initiated members are required to attend bi-weekly meetings on 1st and 3rd Monday of every month at 5:00pm and participate in Order of Omega sponsored events.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

To be eligible for membership in Order of Omega, a student shall meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Applicants must have at least one full academic year at USU.
- 2. Junior or Senior (undergraduate) standing.
- 3. Rank academically above the all-Greek average; 3.11 GPA or higher.
- 4. Be in good standing with their FSL organization.
