

SPOUSE PASS SEMESTER ACCESS

GENERAL INFORMATION

What is a Spouse Pass?

The spouse of a student may gain access to the following:

- Athletic Events
- ARC/Nelson Fieldhouse Fitness Center
- Campus Recreation
- USUSA Events
- Music/Theatre Production Discounts
- Building Use

The Spouse Pass does **NOT** include:

- Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS)
- Student Health Services

What is required for a Spouse Pass?

First time Requirements:

- Must be legally married to a registered USU student.
- BOTH spouses must be present with a valid govt. picture ID.
- Provide official state or govt. marriage documentation (religious certificates not accepted).
- All prior USU financial obligations must be *PAID at the time of request.
 - If the spouse is a former USU student, all prior financial obligations must also be PAID.

Renewal Requirements:

- Renewal requests <u>may</u> be sent to <u>registrar@usu.edu</u> from the registered USU student's A# email OR submitted to the Registrar's Office (TSC 246).
- All prior USU financial obligations must be *PAID at the time of request.
 - If the spouse is a former USU student, all prior financial obligations must also be PAID.

When can a Spouse Pass be purchased?

A Spouse Pass may be *purchased beginning 1 week before the first day of class in each semester.

*Must be paid with CASH or CHECK at the Registrar's Office (TSC) 246, M-F, 8am-5pm.

IMPORTANT: The Spouse Pass will take 24 hours to activate after the \$40 is paid on the spouse's account.

How long does a Spouse Pass last?

It will be valid up until the first day of class of the following semester.

^{*}Students on a Payment Plan must be up to date with their payments with the Bursar's Office to be considered PAID.
